Qualifications:

- At least three years experience or formal training in the specialty area.
- At least two years experience working with children or college level education.

Responsibilities:

1. Lead and motivate children to participate in area of specialty.
2. Ensure safety and health of campers.
3. Maintain cleanliness and orderly work areas.
4. Plan age appropriate activities centered on the study of nature and science using the park, local fauna, etc. as an “outdoor classroom”.
5. Report any incidents or accidents to the Medical Director as soon as possible by using the Camps Emergency Action Plan.
6. Completes an Accident/Incident Report on any emergency situation.
7. Responsible for promoting good personal relationships.
8. Inventory first aid supplies before and during the camp season.
9. Request needed supplies to Camp Director.
10. May be required to perform additional supervisory duties as directed by the Camp Director.
11. Attend Pre-camp Training Sessions and all staff meetings.
12. Conduct oneself in a professional manner at all times as a representative of the Hyde Park Recreation Department

Pay Rate:

- **No one is allowed in the Crum Elbow Creek-** per Dutchess County Health Department. Please ensure the campers safety next to the creek by keeping them from reaching into deep or fast moving water. Campers are not permitted to cross the creek.
